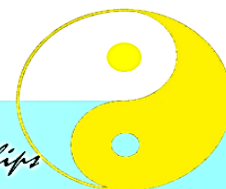

## Basic Information about Scotland

### Background of Scotland

- Scotland is a country that is part of the United Kingdom and covers the northern third of the island of Great Britain. Edinburgh is the capital city of Scotland. It is Scotland's second most populous city and the seventh most populous in the United Kingdom. It is the largest financial centre in the UK after London.

### Attractions in Edinburgh

- Edinburgh is home to the Scottish Parliament and the seat of the monarchy in Scotland. The city is also the annual venue of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland and home to national institutions such as the National Museum of Scotland, the National Library of Scotland and the Scottish National Gallery. The city's historical and cultural attractions have attracted over one million overseas visitors each year. Historic sites in Edinburgh include Edinburgh Castle, Holyrood Palace, the churches of St. Giles, Greyfriars and the Canongate etc.

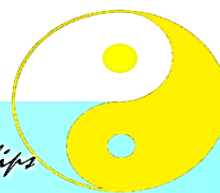
### The weather of Edinburgh

- Scotland has four seasons; spring, summer, autumn, and winter. However, the changeable nature of the climate means it's not uncommon to experience all four seasons in one day! Winter daytime temperatures rarely fall below freezing. January and February are generally the coldest months in Scotland, with the daytime maximum temperatures averaging around 5 °C to 7 °C. Summer temperatures are normally moderate. July and August are normally the warmest months in Scotland, with temperatures at an average 19 °C.

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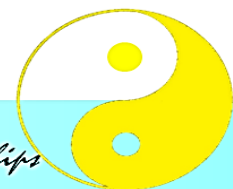
### Activity 1 Thought about the experience in Edinburgh

Do you find any other interesting things about Edinburgh?	

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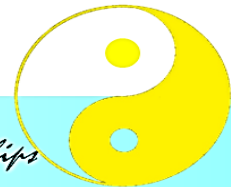
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### **Activity 2 Mind map drawing**

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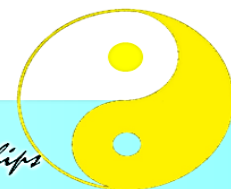
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### Activity 3 Summary of the learning at the spots

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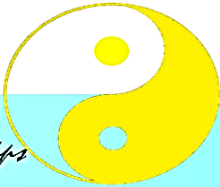
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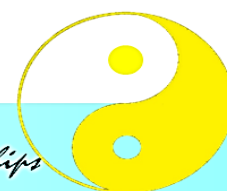
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
